



How to obtain Investment registration certificate

This Certificate is to confirm that the investment has been registered in the Investment general registry, and the investment in process of establishment, and it is a potential investment that would be qualified to benefit from the Law No. [1] of 1998 on the Encouragement of Investment in Palestine and its amendments, and all concerned authorities should provide the investment all the necessary facilitations to facilitate achieving the level of operation and production.

To receive the Investment registration certificate an application need to be completed,
- The application can be obtained from the One-Stop Shop or from PIPA's portal (www.pipa.ps); the following supportive documents should be attached to the application:

1- Project Registration Certificate which means the certificate of the founder entity of the project including any company, branch, trust, partnership, individual property or other institutions

2- Description of the investment*: This description includes the nature of the investment work and the final product or services, the investment estimated capital, location, employees and any other available information on the investment.

*: Description must be clearly printed and signed by the applicant.

By submitting the application, the registered investment certificate issued within Seven (7) working days, if the investment is potentially can benefit from the Law No. [1] of 1998 on the encouragement of Investment in Palestine and its amendments.
